#### INVITATION TO BID

1. The solicitation due (opening) date remains 10/21/09, at 3:00/ p.m.
2. IB.37:ALTERNATE BIDS- This section applies to the box proceeding this paragraph should be marked by an "X"
3. IB.40 BRAND NAMES OR EQUALS: This section is a duplication of section IB.14 and is deleted from the bid document
4. SC.8 LIQUIDATED DAMAGES, PARAGRAPH a.: There is a formatting error in the document and this paragraph of this section appears to be highlighted in the bid document. This paragraph a. does not apply to this project. Only paragraph b. of this section applies to this project.
5. SC.13 MODELS/PROTOTYPE: The first sentence of this section should read: "The RTC may request and award as Additional Work a Prototype of the product offered." Delete the phrase ", at no cost to the" at the end of the first line of this section.
6. BID PROPOSAL FORM:

#### A. BID SCHEDULE-BASE CONTRACT-ADDITIONAL WORK

Prototype-General Market Bus Shelter (to deliver 90 days after award) is incorrectly identified as Item No. 3. The correct item No. is 2.

## QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

1. Are shop drawings to be submitted with bid, or are vendors just supposed to price according to the Bus Shelter Prototype Drawings?

Answer: Bidders to price according to the Bus Shelter Prototype Drawings. Any proposed deviations must be submitted in advance as a question to this bid and will be responded to via addendum. Variances to specifications in a final bid proposal must be submitted pursuant to section IB.33 of the Invitation to Bid (ITB) document.

2. Page 23, SC13 MODELS/PROTOTYPE states that a Prototype may be ordered at no additional cost..... but the text gets a bit cut off. Please clarify.

Answer: The first sentence of section SC 13 should read: "The RTC may request and award as Additional Work a Prototype of the product offered. Please delete the additional text on the first line ", at no cost to the" as it is not applicable.

3. Besides the drawing, are there any written specifications available?

Answer: No.

4. PAGE A-3 shows a single shelter, where PAGE A-4 shows a double shelter configuration with 2 shelters in mirror image. For the pricing page, what is a "UNIT OF MEASURE/EACH? One shelter or 2?


Answer: EACH means a single shelter. The RTC intends to purchase single shelters. Most will have the ad box on the left (when looking at the shelter from streetside). In locations where the RTC installs two shelters at one stop, both a left-hand and right-hand shelter will be ordered so that the two can be pushed together. The RTC will specify at bid award (base), and notice to proceed of option work, the number of left or right side shelters to be delivered as part of the order.
