Notice of Public Hearing Regarding the RTC Proposed Fare Adjustment

The Regional Transportation Commission of Southern Nevada (RTC) is proposing to adjust its premium service up-charge fare. This adjustment has been identified to allow the RTC to continue to provide parity and uniformity throughout the fare structure.

Currently, passengers can purchase an up-charge fare with an RTC 24-hour General Market Pass for \$1. The RTC is proposing to adjust the up-charge fare to \$2.

A public hearing regarding the proposed transit fare adjustment will take place at 8:45 a.m., Thursday, October 8, 2009, at the RTC Board of Commissioners' meeting which will be held at the Clark County Government Center, 500 S. Grand Central Pkwy., Las Vegas, NV 89155.

Comments are also being accepted during a thirty-day comment period beginning Monday, September 7, 2009 through Thursday, October 8, 2009.
