**RTC visiting neighborhoods to provide information about
new ACE Rapid Transit Service**

The Regional Transportation Commission of Southern Nevada (RTC) announced that it will be visiting various community centers, libraries, shopping malls and other locations across the Las Vegas Valley over the next few months to share information about the new ACE Rapid Transit service.

The first ACE rapid transit line, the ACE Gold line, will link Downtown Las Vegas with the Las Vegas Convention Center and the Las Vegas Strip. ACEExpress service will provide fast, limited-stop service from the Centennial Hills area to Downtown and will have continuing service to the resort corridor and UNLV. Both ACE and ACEExpress debut in March.

The RTC is committed to visiting neighborhoods across the valley so residents can conveniently obtain information and answers about its new ACE and ACEExpress services. RTC staff will be on hand to meet with neighbors and answer their questions. Information about additional RTC transit services will also be available.
