On September 12, 2013, the RTC approved and adopted by Resolution No. 315 to support local hiring and develop opportunities for local Nevada residents to become employed on planned fuel tax indexing projects and identify workers and local companies, especially those that support minority, disadvantaged and women-owned businesses.**



# RFP 14-089 Transportation Investment Strategy Study

## *Study Objective*

The purpose of this study is to analyze the demands upon the existing transportation system and determine how strategic investment in transportation infrastructure will affect the economy of the Resort Corridor (including the Convention District).

The study will consider potential growth sectors, related project development, visitor as well as employee mobility, and the resultant demand on the transportation system.



# RFP 14-089 Transportation Investment Strategy Study

## *Transportation Needs and Basis for Study*

- Las Vegas Convention and Visitors Authority is planning a \$2.5B transformative capital investment in its facilities.
- How do people access the Convention Center?
- How do people move between activity centers within the Resort Corridor, including the airport, hotel properties, event venues and other convention spaces?
- How does mobility enhance or detract from the visitor experience?
- How does transportation infrastructure enable or limit economic growth?

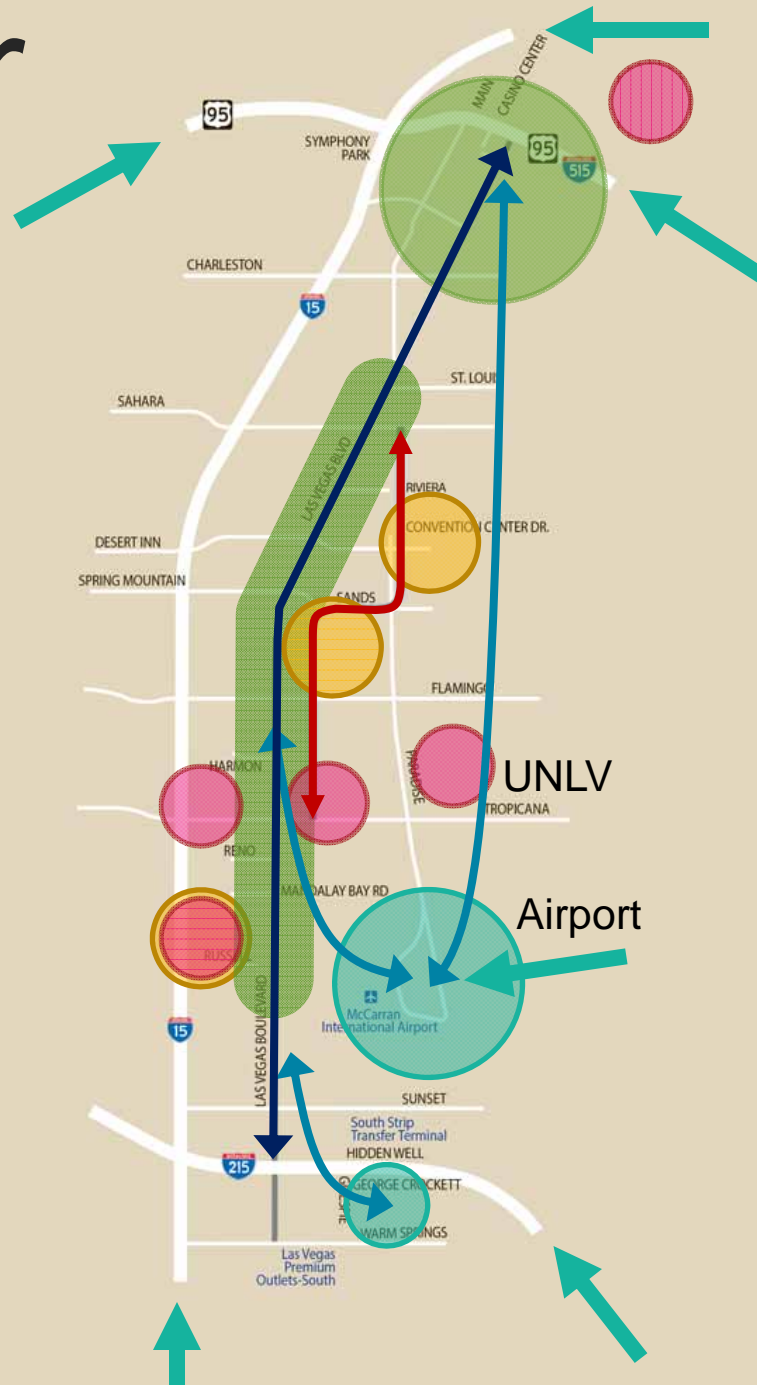
