April 26-May 2

We are entering the second week of construction for the Flamingo Corridor Improvements project. Please see construction updates below.

Howard Hughes Parkway to Paradise Road;

Ongoing sewer work with 24hr traffic control restrictions. From 9 p.m. - 5 a.m. Sunday through Thursday evenings, travel lanes will be restricted to one lane eastbound during night work. Two travel lanes will be open during non-work hours. This work will be ongoing for approximately 3 weeks. There will be a combination of temporary bus stops and/or delays associated with these lane closures that may impact stops in this area.

Grand Canyon Drive to Rainbow Boulevard;

Ongoing median work will have lane closures both East and West bound during nighttime and daytime hours. Two travel lanes will be open during median work. This work will be in effect until May 1.

Starting May 4, work will move from the medians to the outside shoulders from Grand Canyon to Rainbow. East bound lanes will be restricted to a single travel lane from Grand Canyon to Buffalo during bus stop construction activities. This work will be for the next 4 weeks. There will be a combination of temporary bus stops and/or delays associated with these lane closures that may impact stops in this area.
