CONSTRUCTION UPDATE - WEEK OF JANUARY 25, 2016

UPCOMING SPECIAL EVENT CLOSURE

Clark County has approved closures along Flamingo Road for a special event scheduled for Jan. 31 to Feb. 4. Closures include:

* 24 hours a day - Eastbound curb lane will be closed from Las Vegas Boulevard to Linq Lane.

* 8 p.m. - 6 a.m. - All eastbound lanes closed and center westbound lane closed from Las Vegas Boulevard to Koval Lane.

Jones Boulevard to Decatur Boulevard

Median improvements, including concrete and paving work, will begin requiring eastbound and westbound median lane closures for approximately three weeks.

Decatur Boulevard to Valley View Boulevard

Bus stop construction will leave two lanes open in the eastbound direction for approximately one week.

Koval Lane to Paradise Road

Bus stop construction will continue with three travel lanes open in each direction for approximately two weeks.

Paradise Road to Eastern Avenue

There will be various sidewalk closures for Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) ramp improvements for approximately three weeks.

Escondido Street to Palos Verdes Street

Median improvements, including concrete and paving work, will begin requiring eastbound and westbound median lane closures for approximately three weeks.

Eastern Avenue to Sandhill Road

Electrical work will continue requiring intermittent temporary overnight traffic restrictions with intermittent right-lane closure from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. with all lanes back open to traffic during the daytime hours. These restrictions will be in place until February.

Bus Stop Impacts

Detours and temporary stops are in place for the following eastbound stops:

Arville (919), Burnham (926), Cameron (930), Claymont (932), Decatur (933), Tuscany Casino Drive (946), Koval (955), Maryland Parkway (961), 968 Palos Verdes (968), Paradise (970), Hospital Circle (972), Spencer (987), Swenson (990), Tamarus (992), Valley View (996) and Royal Flush Way (1000).

Nevada Department of Transportation (NDOT) Tropicana Avenue Roadwork

NDOT has started work on Tropicana Avenue between Eastern Avenue and McLeod Drive. This work is taking place between 8 p.m. and 6 a.m. and may include various lane restrictions. For further information on this work, please contact NDOT at (702) 385-6509.
