## CONSTRUCTION UPDATE - WEEK OF FEBRUARY 1, 2016

### REMINDER - SPECIAL EVENT CLOSURE - JAN. 31 - FEB. 4

Closures continue along Flamingo Road for a special event through Feb. 4. Closures include:

- 24-hours a day - Eastbound right lane closure from Las Vegas Boulevard to Ling Lane.
- 8 p.m. - 6 a.m. - All eastbound lanes closed with one westbound median lane closure from Las Vegas Boulevard to Koval Lane.

### Tropicana Avenue Roadwork

NDOT recently started work on Tropicana Avenue between Eastern Avenue and Pecos Road. Restrictions will include lane closures during overnight hours with possible single-lane closures during daytime hours.

### Jones Boulevard to Valley View Boulevard

Median improvements, including concrete and paving work, continue requiring eastbound and westbound median lane closures for approximately two weeks.

### Koval Lane to Paradise Road

Intermittent nighttime lane closures in both directions for preparation of traffic switch beginning Sunday night to approximately Thursday morning. All three lanes in each direction will remain open during daytime hours. This will be performed for construction of westbound bus pads.

### Paradise Road to Eastern Avenue

There will be various sidewalk closures for Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) ramp improvements for approximately three weeks.

### Escondido Street to Palos Verdes Street

Median improvements, including concrete and paving work, continue requiring eastbound and westbound median lane closures for approximately one week.

### Eastern Avenue to US-95

Electrical work will continue requiring intermittent right-lane closures both during nighttime and daytime hours. These restrictions will be in place until February.

### Bus Stop Impacts

Detours and temporary stops are in place for the following eastbound stops:

919 Arville, 926 Burnham, 932 Claymont, 933 Decatur, 930 Cameron, 946 Tuscan Casino Drive, 955 Koval, 961 Maryland Parkway, 968 Palos Verdes, 970 Paradise, 972 Hospital Circle, 987 Spencer, 990 Swenson, 992 Tamarus, 996 Valley View and 1000 Royal Flush Way
