## Construction Update - Week of October 19, 2015

### Flamingo Road and Paradise Road Intersection

**On Tuesday, Oct. 20, between 8 p.m. and 6 a.m.**, paving work will require a closure for the north half of Flamingo and Paradise intersection. Travel on Paradise Southbound will be detoured onto Swenson St. and northbound Paradise travel will be detoured onto East or West bound Flamingo. One travel lane will remain open in both directions on Flamingo Road.

**On Wednesday, Oct. 21, between 8 p.m. and 6 a.m.**, paving work will require a closure for the South half of Flamingo and Paradise intersection. Travel on Paradise Northbound will be detoured onto Swenson St, Southbound Paradise travel will be detoured onto East or West bound Flamingo. One travel lane will remain open in both directions on Flamingo Road.

**From Tuesday, Oct. 20 to Thursday, Oct. 27 from 8 p.m. - 6 a.m.** Flamingo Road will be reduced to one travel lane. Paradise road will remain open during this period.

### Paradise Road to Eastern Avenue

Bus stop construction and electrical work will continue with both day and night lane closures. Three travel lanes will remain open during day work with two travel lanes open during night work. This work will continue for approximately two weeks.

### Flamingo Road and Eastern Avenue Intersection

Sewer installation work continues to require 24-hour lane restrictions at the intersection of Flamingo Road and Eastern Avenue for two weeks. Two travel lanes will remain open.

### Rainbow Boulevard to Decatur Boulevard - Eastbound

Bus stop construction will continue with three travel lanes eastbound for two weeks.

### Rainbow Boulevard to Decatur Boulevard - Westbound

Beginning Monday, Oct. 19, bus stop construction will require 24-hour lane restrictions. Two travel lanes will remain open for three weeks.

### Rainbow Boulevard to Hotel Rio Drive

Electrical work will continue during overnight hours. Various lane restrictions will be in place for approximately two months.

### Transit Route 202 Detours / Shuttle Service

Transit riders should prepare for the possibility of late departures on Route 202 - Flamingo for the duration of the project.
