## Construction Update - Week of October 26, 2015

### Flamingo Road and Paradise Road Intersection

Paving work will continue to reduce Flamingo Road to one travel lane in each direction through Tuesday, Oct. 27 from 8 p.m. - 6 a.m. Paradise road will remain open during this period.

### Paradise Road to Eastern Avenue

Bus stop construction and electrical work will continue with both day and night lane closures. Three travel lanes will remain open during day work with two travel lanes open during night work. This work will continue for approximately one week.

### Flamingo Road and Eastern Avenue Intersection

Sewer and bus stop construction will continue to require 24-hour lane restrictions at the intersection of Flamingo Road and Eastern Avenue for one week. Two travel lanes will remain open.

### Rainbow Boulevard to Decatur Boulevard - Eastbound

Bus stop construction will continue with three eastbound travel lanes open for one week.

### Decatur Boulevard to Rainbow Boulevard - Westbound

Bus stop construction will require 24-hour lane restrictions. Two travel lanes will remain open for three weeks.

### Rainbow Boulevard to Hotel Rio Drive

Electrical work will continue during overnight hours. Various lane restrictions will be in place for approximately two months.

**Transit Route 202 Detours / Shuttle Service**  
Transit riders should prepare for the possibility of late departures on Route 202 - Flamingo for the duration of the project.
