CONSTRUCTION UPDATE - WEEK OF NOVEMBER 30, 2015

Grand Canyon Drive to Rainbow Boulevard

Work will continue for bus shelter installation for approximately one week. No traffic lanes will be impacted during this work.

Rainbow Boulevard to Decatur Boulevard

Beginning Monday, Nov. 30, median work will begin requiring 24-hour traffic restrictions. Two travel lanes in each direction will remain open for approximately one month.

Paradise Road to Eastern Avenue

Bus stop construction and electrical work will continue with nighttime traffic restrictions. Two travel lanes will remain open during night work between the hours of 9 p.m. and 6 a.m., and three travel lanes will be open during daytime hours. This work will continue for approximately three weeks.

Flamingo Road and Eastern Avenue Intersection

Construction will continue requiring 24-hour lane restrictions. There will be a single right-lane closure on westbound Flamingo Road and southbound Eastern Avenue for approximately two weeks.

Eastern Avenue to Sandhill Road

Electrical work will begin Sunday Nov. 29, requiring overnight traffic restrictions from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. with all lanes back open to traffic during daytime hours.

Transit Route 202 Detours

Transit riders should prepare for the possibility of late departures on Route 202 - Flamingo for the duration of the project.
