CONSTRUCTION UPDATE - WEEK OF NOVEMBER 16, 2015

Grand Canyon Drive to Hotel Rio Drive

Traffic signal work will continue requiring traffic restrictions from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. One travel lane will remain open in both directions for approximately two months.

Rainbow Boulevard to Decatur Boulevard

Bus stop daytime work westbound will continue with no lane restrictions for one week.

Flamingo Road and Cameron Street

Sewer work will continue requiring traffic restrictions from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. One travel lane will remain open for eastbound travel for one month.

Paradise Road to Eastern Avenue

Bus stop construction and electrical work will continue with both day and night traffic restrictions. Three travel lanes will remain open during day work and two travel lanes open during night work. This work will continue for approximately two months.

Flamingo Road and Eastern Avenue Intersection

Construction will continue requiring 24-hour lane restrictions. There will be a single right-lane closure on westbound Flamingo and southbound Eastern Avenue for approximately one week.

Transit Route 202 Detours

Transit riders should prepare for the possibility of late departures on Route 202 - Flamingo for the duration of the project.
