CONSTRUCTION UPDATE - WEEK OF MARCH 7, 2016

Rainbow to Decatur Boulevard

Shelter installation and sidewalk ramp reconstruction will require a westbound right-lane closure for approximately two weeks.

Decatur Boulevard to Hotel Rio Drive

Shelter pad installation and sidewalk ramp reconstruction will require a westbound right-lane closure for approximately two weeks.

Las Vegas Boulevard to Audrie Street*

Electrical work will require a westbound double left-lane closure during overnight hours for one night on Thursday, March 10.

Las Vegas Boulevard to Koval Lane*

Upcoming bus shelter work will require various lane closures from Sunday, March 13 - Wednesday, April 13. Twenty four-hour closures will be in effect during the following timeframes: westbound right-lane closure March 13 - 18 and eastbound right-lane closure March 20 - 25. Overnight closures will be in effect on the following dates: westbound right-lane closure March 27 - April 1 & April 10 - 11 and eastbound right-lane closure April 3 - 8 & April 12 -13.

Koval Lane to Paradise Road

Westbound bus stop and shelter construction will take place for approximately two weeks. Three westbound lanes will remain open during construction.

Flamingo Road & McLeod Drive Intersection

Clark County Water Reclamation District sewer work continues with a 24-hour road closure of northbound and southbound through traffic on McLeod Drive at Flamingo Road for approximately one week. Northbound and southbound traffic on McLeod is limited to right turns only onto Flamingo. Flamingo will have two eastbound and westbound lanes open during the one week of construction.

Eastern Avenue and Flamingo Road - Eastbound Bus Stop #940

Sidewalk and electrical work will take place for approximately two weeks.

Eastern Ave. to Pecos Road

Median island removal, street lighting work, and relocation of fiber optic lines will require a 24-hour left-lane closure in both directions. Work is expected to take approximately three weeks.

Pecos Road to Mojave Road

Clark County Water Reclamation District sewer work continues with a 24-hour westbound right-lane closure for approximately four weeks.

Mojave Road to US-95

Median island removal, street lighting work, and relocation of fiber optic lines will require a 24-hour left-lane closure in both directions. Work is expected to take approximately four weeks. Electrical work will also continue during nighttime and daytime hours in both directions requiring intermittent right-lane closures. Two lanes in each direction will remain open at all times.

Tropicana Avenue Roadwork

The Nevada Department of Transportation is continuing work along Tropicana Avenue between Eastern Avenue and Mountain Vista Street. A 24-hour left-lane closure is currently in place between Eastern Avenue and McLeod Drive in both directions. Other areas will experience lane closures during overnight hours with possible single-lane closures during daytime hours.
