CONSTRUCTION UPDATE - WEEK OF APRIL 25, 2016

Paradise Road to Eastern Avenue

Safety/ Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) improvements will require intermittent shoulder closures during daytime hours in both directions for approximately two weeks.

Pecos Road to Mojave Road

Clark County Water Reclamation District sewer work continues with a 24-hour westbound right-lane closure through May 30.

Eastern Avenue to Sandhill Road

Median island removal, street lighting work, and relocation of fiber optic lines will require a 24-hour left-lane closure in both directions through April 29. Electrical work will also continue during nighttime and daytime hours in both directions requiring intermittent right-lane closures. Two lanes in each direction will remain open at all times.

US-95 to Mountain Vista

Work by Southwest Gas will require a westbound double right-lane closure from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. through May 6.

US 95 to Boulder Highway

Electrical work during daytime hours will require intermittent right-lane closures in both directions.
