

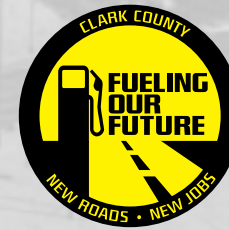

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CONSTRUCTION UPDATE - WEEK OF MAY 30, 2016

Grand Canyon Parkway to I-215

Roadway resurfacing will require various double left-lane and double right-lane closures from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. in the westbound direction for approximately one week. This work is needed to install surfacing, final striping, and raise underground utilities.

Spring Valley Pkwy to Flamingo Road, Rainbow Boulevard at Flamingo Road

For approximately one week, underground utility work on the northeast corner of Flamingo & Rainbow will require a 24-hour right-lane closure on Rainbow from Spring Valley to Flamingo in the northbound direction. Work will also require a 24-hour shoulder closure on Flamingo Road in the westbound direction. Two northbound through lanes on Rainbow and three westbound through lanes on Flamingo will remain open.

Overnight Traffic Signal Shut Down

The following stop lights will operate as a four-way stop from 9 p.m. - 5:30 a.m. on the following dates:

Sunday, May 29 - Flamingo and Arville

Monday, May 30 - Flamingo and Decatur

Rainbow Boulevard to Decatur Boulevard

Median landscaping work will continue with left-lane closures in both directions from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. for approximately two weeks.

Decatur Boulevard to Arville Street

Median island construction requiring 24-hour left-lane closures in both directions for approximately one week is expected to start at the end of next week.

Koval Lane to Paradise Road

Roadway resurfacing will require various double left-lane and double right-lane closures from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. in both directions for four weeks. This work is needed to lower underground utilities, install traffic signal loops, and place asphalt.

Paradise Road to Eastern Avenue

Roadway resurfacing and median island construction will require various double left-lane and double right-lane closures from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. in both directions for two months. This work is needed to lower underground utilities, install traffic signal loops, and place asphalt.

Eastern Avenue to Boulder Highway

Bus shelter work will continue requiring a right-lane closure in the eastbound direction for approximately one week. Safety/ Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) work will require various right-lane closures during daytime hours. Electrical work will also continue during nighttime and daytime hours in both directions requiring intermittent right-lane closures. Two lanes in each direction will remain open at all times.
