## Construction Update - Week of July 20, 2015

### Flamingo Road at Swenson Street

Ongoing sewer work will continue with 24-hour traffic control restrictions. From 9 p.m. - 5 a.m. Sunday through Thursday, travel lanes along Flamingo Road and Swenson Street will be restricted during night work. During non-work hours, two travel lanes along Flamingo Road will remain open.

### Koval Lane to Paradise Road

Water line repair work continues requiring 24-hour lane restrictions. Please be alert to current traffic configurations as the work progresses.

### Paradise Road to Eastern Avenue

Median construction will continue to close the inside lane in both the eastbound and westbound directions. This closure will take place 24-hours a day for approximately two to three months.

### Riley Street to Buffalo

Beginning on Monday, July 20, new pedestrian shelter installation will take place on the west bound side of Flamingo from Riley Street to Buffalo Drive and will require various short-term closures. Please use caution in the area.

### Rainbow Boulevard to Durango Boulevard - Eastbound

Work to install pedestrian shelters will require a right lane closure during various hours. This restriction will be in place for one week.

### Transit Route 202 Detours / Shuttle Service

Due to the long-term construction project on Flamingo Road east of Boulder Highway and resulting delays, route 202 will be shortened and a shuttle will cover the service lost by the shortened route. This change went into effect April 24 and will continue two weeks.
