Construction Update - Week of September 14, 2015

Koval Lane to Paradise Road

Water line repair work continues requiring 24-hour lane restrictions. Please be alert to current traffic configurations as the work progresses.

Paradise Road to Eastern Avenue

Work will continue on the outside lanes for bus stop construction activities. Westbound travel will be restricted to two lanes 24 hours a day. This work will continue for approximately three weeks.

Rainbow Boulevard to Decatur Boulevard - eastbound

Beginning on September 14, bus stop construction will begin restricting eastbound travel to two lanes for three weeks. These restrictions will be in place 24-hours a day.

Rainbow Boulevard to Hotel Rio Drive

Electrical work will continue during overnight hours. Various lane restrictions will be in place for approximately two months.

Transit Route 202 Detours / Shuttle Service

Transit riders should prepare for the possibility of late departures on Route 202 - Flamingo for the duration of the project.
