We are excited to announce that work on the Flamingo Corridor Improvement Project will begin this coming week. As promised, we will be sharing weekly updates on this project.

Howard Hughes Parkway to Paradise Road:

Beginning Sunday, April 19, sewer work will require 24-hour traffic restrictions. From 9 p.m. - 5 a.m. each evening, Sunday through Thursday, traffic will be restricted to one lane eastbound. Two lanes of travel will be open during day time hours. This will be in effect for approximately three weeks.

Grand Canyon Drive to Rainbow Boulevard:

Beginning Monday, April 20, there will be inside lane closures in both directions to allow for median work during daytime and night time hours affecting both eastbound and westbound traffic. Two lanes in each direction will be open during this time. This will be in effect for approximately 2-3 months.
