

NEVADA TRANSPORTATION DISPARITY STUDY

Harry Reid International Airport & Regional Transportation Commission

Harry Reid International Airport (LAS) and the Regional Transportation Commission of Southern Nevada (RTC) have retained BBC Research & Consulting to conduct a disparity study to examine LAS and RTC contracting and procurement. BBC will conduct the disparity study in partnership with MYS Firm, a local certified DBE.

The disparity study will:

- Assess marketplace conditions for the local business community
- Help LAS and RTC identify ways to make contracting opportunities more accessible to small businesses, as well as POC-, woman-, LGBTQ+, and veteran-owned businesses



Outcomes from the disparity study conducted in 2018 include:

- Increased **overall goals** for participation of disadvantaged business enterprises (DBEs) in federally funded work
 - LAS increased goals from 5.8% to 16.8%
 - RTC increased goals from 4.1% to 18.1%
- Continued use of **race-/gender-based contract goals** for POC-/woman-owned businesses
- RTC implemented the **RiSE Program** to encourage local small and diverse business participation
