OVERVIEW

The RTC and CCSD are collaborating to launch the RTC Ride On program to provide high school students with an option to ride RTC transit to and from school, FREE of charge.

PREREQUISITES

Sign up using the QR code or online at rtcsonv.com/RideOn to enroll in the Ride On program and register your student pass.

GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

As a result of this lesson, students should be able to ride the bus with a clear understanding of the guidelines.

ASSIGNMENTS

Download the **rideRTC App** at rtcsonv.com/ridertc

- Activate your pass before boarding the bus.
- Plan your next trip using rideRTC with detailed step-by-step information.
- Get arrival information for routes and stops near you and where you want to go.

When you are at your transit stop waiting for the bus:

- Be sure you are visible so the driver knows to stop.
- Have your pass ready as the bus approaches.
- Check the vehicle header sign for the route number and direction you desire since many stops serve more than one route.
- Keep money and other valuables put away.

When you board the bus, be sure to hold onto handrails as you find a seat. The bus may begin to move before you sit down.

When you are on the bus:

- Stay behind the yellow line while the bus is in motion.
- Use headphones so you do not disturb others.
- Do not eat or drink on the bus.
- Do not block the aisles, doors, or stairwells.
- Refrain from shoving, fighting, shouting, vulgar language, or other disruptive behavior.
- Do not smoke, chew tobacco, vape, or use electronic cigarettes.
- Keep all of your possessions with you at all times while you are on the bus. Before you leave, look around your seat to make sure you do not leave anything behind.

When you exit the bus, hold onto the door handles until you clear the door.
