PILOT PROGRAM

The Livable Centers Study is a pilot program led by the **Regional Transportation Commission of Southern Nevada (RTC)** and **Southern Nevada Strong**, in partnership with a selected local jurisdiction.

The RTC will fund the completion of one pilot project in each of the next two years. The City of North Las Vegas received Phase I funds for the **Deer Springs District**.

Livable Centers support the goals and strategies of the Regional Transportation Plan (RTP), Access 2040. Study recommendations will lead to locally sponsored Livable Centers projects for possible inclusion in the RTP and potential future funding.

GOALS

Livable Centers are a strategy to achieve the vision and goals of the Southern Nevada Strong (SNS) regional plan for improving economic competitiveness, investing in complete communities, increasing transportation choices, and building capacity for implementation
